VERIFIED COMPLAINT (COMP)

Plaintiff Spelios and Associates, P.A., complaining of Defendant Lorna Dewalle, alleges and says as follows:

PARTIES, JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 1. Plaintiff Spelios and Associates, P.A. ("Spelios and Associates") is a professional association with a principal place of business in Wake County, North Carolina.
- 2. Defendant Lorna Dewalle is a natural born person who, upon information and belief, is domiciled in and a resident of Cary, Wake County, North Carolina.
- This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties of this action, and venue is proper.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

- 4. On or about January 15, 2009, Defendant attended a dental appointment at the office of Spelios and Associates located in Cary, North Carolina.
- 5. Spelios and Associates is a dental practice that provides a variety of dental services for patients.
- 6. As is customary, Spelios and Associates recommended that Defendant, a new patient, have dental X-rays taken and a comprehensive examination.

- 7. After conducting the examination and reviewing Defendant's X-rays, the examining dentist reached a diagnosis.
- The dentist explained the diagnosis to Defendant and recommended a particular treatment.
- Defendant indicated that she understood the diagnosis and had no further questions.
- 10. Defendant made an appointment with Spelios and Associates to have the recommended treatment.
- 11. On or about February 3, 2009, Defendant changed her mind and declined the recommended treatment. Plaintiff told Spelios and Associates that she did not agree with the diagnosis and did not believe the recommended treatment was necessary.
- 12. Defendant demanded that Spelios and Associates reverse the charges to her dental insurance company for the previously performed X-rays and examination.
- 13. Because Spelios and Associates had actually taken the X-rays and conducted the dental examination, it declined to reverse the charges to the insurance company.
- 14. Upon information and belief, on or about March 27, 2009, Defendant contacted the *News & Observer* and made false statements to Leah Friedman, a reporter for the newspaper's "Troubleshooter" division about Spelios and Associates. The newspaper published an article March 28, 2009 summarizing Defendant's complaints and misstatements.
- 15. Upon information and belief, Defendant falsely told Leah Friedman that Spelios and Associates misdiagnosed her and told her that she needed a particular treatment when in fact she did not.
 - 16. Additionally, following the publishing of the article in the newspaper, on or about

March 30, 2009, Defendant posted defamatory statements on the *News & Observer*'s online blog about Spelios and Associates, including the following statements:

- (a) "They [Spelios and Associates] blatantly lied and misdiagnosed and that is the issue... I would like them to reverse my charges so I can see a reputable dentist and not have to pay out of pocket."
- (b) "This is clearly about ethics or lack there of and taking advantage of consumers."
- 17. Upon information and belief, Defendant also solicited readers of the blog to contact her directly "so we can pursue this."
- 18. After Defendant made defamatory statements about Spelios and Associates, numerous patients scheduled to see dentists at the three offices in Wake County have called the practice and cancelled appointments. Many of the patients cited Defendant's statements in the newspaper as the reason for their the cancellation.

FIRST CLAIMS FOR RELIEF

(Libel per se and libel per quod)

- 19. Plaintiff repeats and realleges the allegations contained in the preceding paragraphs of the Complaint as if set forth fully herein.
- 20. Defendant's statements on the *News & Observer*'s online blog that Spelios and Associates "blatantly lied and misdiagnosed" her, as well as her statements indicating that Spelios and Associates is not a "reputable" dentist facility, "lacks in ethics", and is "taking advantage of consumers" are false.
 - 21. Defendant made the false statements in writing.
- 22. Defendant posted the false statements on a website accessible to the public and directed the false statements to individuals other than Plaintiff.
 - 23. Defendant's false statements have a tendency to impeach the business reputation

of Spelios and Associates and falsely impute conduct derogatory to Plaintiff's character and standing as a business.

- 24. Defendant's false statements tend to prejudice Spelios and Associates in its reputation, trade, and business.
- 25. Defendant made these false statements maliciously or with willful and wanton conduct, intending to injure Plaintiff.
- 26. As a result of Defendant's false statements, Spelios and Associates has in fact been injured, as several patients have cancelled scheduled appointments and cited to the newspaper article and related blog notes as the reason for the cancellation.

SECOND CLAIMS FOR RELIEF

(Slander per se and per quod)

- 27. Plaintiff repeats and realleges the allegations contained in the preceding paragraphs of the Complaint as if set forth fully herein.
- 28. Defendant made derogatory statements about Plaintiff's ability to provide dental services and Plaintiff's conduct as a dental practice.
 - 29. Defendant's statement about Plaintiff are false.
 - 30. Defendant made the false statements orally.
- 31. Defendant made these false statements to Leah Friedman, staff writer for *News & Observer*, among others.
- 32. Defendant's false statements impeach Plaintiff's business and falsely impute conduct derogatory to Plaintiff's character and standing as a business.
- 33. Defendant's false statements tend to prejudice Plaintiff in its reputation, trade, and business.

- 34. Defendant made these false statements maliciously and with willful and wanton conduct, intending to injure Plaintiff.
- 35. Defendant's defamatory statements have a tendency to impeach the business reputation of Spelios and Associates.
- 36. As a result of Defendant's false statements, Spelios and Associates has in fact been injured, as several patients have cancelled scheduled appointments.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully prays the Court as follows:

- 1. That Plaintiff be awarded compensatory damages against Defendant in an amount in excess of \$10,000;
- That Plaintiff be awarded punitive damages against Defendant in an amount to be determined at trial;
- That Plaintiff have and recover from Defendants the costs and expenses of this action, including interest and fees;
 - 4. A jury trial on all issues so triable; and
 - For such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
